## Region 11 CYO HS Boys \& Girls Basketball League 2011-12

Revised 10/25/11
Primary Rules: PIAA
Length of Game:

- Four 8-Minute Quarters ; 5-Minute Half; 3-Minute Overtime(s) as needed until game is decided;
- Clock stops on all whistles. The game is counted as official upon reaching halftime.
- End of Game Rule: If a team is ahead by 20 points or more and the clock
has less than two minutes in the 4th quarter then the game will be declared over immediately at either coaches or referee's discretion.
- Game may start with 4 players but 5th player must be in by start of 2 nd quarter otherwise it'll be considered a forfeit for the team that is short the player.


## Eligibility:

Varsity - All athletes to be 11th or 12th grade students who have not reached their nineteenth birthday before 9/1/11.
Junior Varsity - All athletes to be 9th or 10th grade students who have not reached their seventeenth birthday before $9 / 1 / 11$.
Referee Fees: $\$ 40$ per ref (each team pays one of the 2 refs) (if only one ref then each team pays \$30)
In the event of a forfeit the offending team pays both refs
Ball/Clock/Book: Regulation size basketball, official scorer and timer provided by home team.
Women's ball used in Girls League. No talking to the scoring table please.
Possession/3's: Jump ball at start of game and each overtime. Alternate possession thereafter regardless of reason for the jump.
Count 3-pointers if the floor has appropriate markings.
Foul Shots: Shoot 1-and-1 on 7th Foul, 2 shots on 10th foul in each half.
Full Court Press: Full court press at any time except once a team is ahead by 18 or more points (15 points for Girls Varsity games)
that team may not press until the lead drops to 17 points ( 14 for Girls) or less.
Team behind may press regardless of score.
Timeouts: Three (3) full time-outs and two (2) 20 second time-outs per game, used any time but expire at end of regulation.
One (1) additional full time-out each overtime.
Uniforms: Players must wear gym shorts and/or basketball uniform with number of matching color.
Jewelry: Absolutely NO watches, earrings, barrettes, plastic or metal hair bands of any kind. TAPING OVER EARRINGS IS NOT PERMITTED (safety issue-no exceptions).
Weather Postponements: The commissioner will be the final authority in deciding whether games will be played.
Home team must notify the commissioner of cancellation at least 3 hours before start of game.
Every effort will be made to give each team as much advance notice of cancellations as possible.
Code of Conduct:Any player who receives two unsportsmanlike technical fouls in a game will be ejected from the game
and suspended from the team's next game (including Region and Archdiocese playoffs and CYO sponsored tournaments).
Any coach who is ejected from a game will be suspended from the team's next game
(including Region and Archdiocese playoffs and CYO sponsored tournaments).
A second ejection, for a coach or player, will result in a five game suspension.
A third ejection, for a coach or player, will result in removal from the league for the remainder of the season.
Dunking is not permitted (including warmup). Result: technical foul

Roster \& Playoffs: Submit roster to your AD.
Playoffs: All teams make the playoffs. Season will end no later than 2/23/11. All-Star Game to be announced.
Archdiocesan Playoffs start 2/25 .
Conduct: Please keep in mind that we are here to play basketball. Ugly behavior reflects badly on you and your team.
Let the games be decided on the court. Also keep in mind that the referees may make a mistake and it's part of the game.
The behavior of their fans is the responsibility of each coach. Your team may face a penalty if your fans get out of control.
