Important Note Field events are not open pits. Competitors must take their turn in order, unless participating in running events, then they must follow the event conflict rules (Track Packet Page 8). It is recommended that when there is a conflict with a running event the athlete or the athlete's coach clerk them into the running event, advise the head official of the running event that the athlete is continuing to participate in the field event. The field event official will allow the athlete to take their remaining attempts out of order in order for them to complete their attempts before participating in the running event. If all remaining participants at the field event completed their attempts the event will be closed. A runner who has left the field event, without completing their attempts, will not be given attempts when they return if the event has already been closed.
*Field Events will not start prior to scheduled times, however they may run behind schedule.
